* Spanish Score Verification Process:

Students who place out of SPAN 1103 will be placed into SPAN 2202 depending on the successful, timely completion of the SPAN 1103 Verification Exam. Students must pass with an 80% or higher in order to verify their placement score. Students will have two (2) weeks from the day they take the MultiCAT to take the SPAN 1103 Verification Exam. Failure to take the Verification Exam in the two-week period will result in the student being placed into SPAN 1103. You will be contacted to verify your placement.
